The 3rd edition of the Architecture Festival will take place in Bari from Tuesday to Thursday 16th-18th May 2017. PugliArch is a communication network and a meeting where participants will discuss their ideas, collaborating to exchange their experiences and ideas about the city of the future.

This will be the beginning of a cycle of assemblies among Protagonists of European contemporary architectural panorama, which coming from different countries, giving the opportunity to show their cultural, historical and environmental background as well as the project experiences on theme "tomorrow city" in the National and International context.

PugliArch's goal is to have an extraordinary experience with a European Assembly founded by Puglia's architects. It's an event organized by ordinary people for ordinary people, from young people who are able to propose, eager to open up to multi-share opportunities that the diversity of the European landscape and the Mediterranean basin offer. The mission is "managing and adopting a festival on a cooperative basis".

The objectives of the project, therefore, are included in the Puglia Region program of FESR 2014-2020, of which it enjoys funding.

PugliArch is a wish to cross different experiences on the topic, to make a new step towards that slow, gradual and unstoppable process called the Europeanization and involvement of Mediterranean cultures.

Making Architecture today means contributing to be culture in the tomorrow's cities: Tomorrow's City themes, now shared in the international discussion, are topics that definitely require great practical and theoretical knowledge, not just from the technological's viewpoint, but also historical, and the awareness of the administrations and civil society that must be moved towards the acquisition of the know-how that comes from the knowledge of the best contemporary experiences in Italy and abroad.

The working group (Palma Librato, Francesco Pastore, Maurizio Dalena, Valentina Distaso, Lucrezia Montalbò, Antonella Berardi) wanted to become a permanent biennial appointment starting from the 2012 edition, in fact mark was registered. The project of the year, "Tomorrow city", focuses on the city of the future: from urban regeneration to the "smart" city. The aim is to investigate the future view of the cities of our country, far from the European debate on advanced and futuristic technology at the service of the architecture.

The future must start from "re-thinking", "re-looking", "re-designing" the city through the involvement of a multitude of actors, local, national and international, public and private, who are able to operate in co-ordinated way for the territory development, and are capable to promoting concrete actions in favor of talent and creativity, considered to be crucial factors in social, economic and cultural development.

The year's theme of the tomorrow city, therefore, is developed through the antinomies we daily live. On this occasion we try to explain a cultural theme that contemporary society lives.
